India's first comic, Tinkle was launched in 1980. 40,000 copies of the first issue were sold out, confirming its popularity. Supandi, Shambhu, Shikari, Anwar and Kalia the crow, Pai's popular characters have always touched the hearts of children in a special way and are famous throughout India.

Besides comics, Uncle Pai also wrote books on Personality Development for students, teachers and parents. Uncle Pai was awarded a lifetime achievement award at India's first comic convention in Delhi. He left behind him a rich legacy of wholesome and natural characters.
