PARENT ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
CLASS XI SESSION (2017 - 2018)

Dear Parents,

The progress of the students is a combined effort of both the teachers and parents so we would like to enlighten you about the vast and various changes in the syllabus in class XI as compared to class X, so as to enable a smooth transition for the students from the CCE curriculum to the Senior Secondary curriculum. Please refer to the CBSE website at www.cbse.nic.in for all the latest updates and the school website at www.indianschoolsohar.com, where all the circulars issued by the school are regularly updated.

1. SUBJECTS OFFERED:

- a. **SCIENCE: Compulsory subjects:** ENGLISH, PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY,
Elective subjects (any two): MATHS, BIOLOGY, I.P / PE.
- b. **COMMERCE: Compulsory subjects:** ENGLISH, ACCOUNTANCY, BUSINESS STUDIES,
Elective subjects (any two): MATHS / I.P / P.E, ECONOMICS / ENTREPRENEURSHIP.

2. UNIFORM:

- a. Students should be in proper uniform at all times.
- b. Students who come to school for any purpose what so ever should be in proper school uniform.
- c. White uniform must be worn by the students on Tuesdays.
- d. No jewellery should be worn to school by the students.

3. PERSONAL BELONGINGS:

- a. Student should not bring things other than study materials to school.
- b. Mobile phones, USBs, Laptops, CDs should not be brought to school.
- c. Mobile phones and other electronic gadgets once confiscated from the students will not be returned.
- d. Students should carry their student diary to school every day, even on examination days.

4. DISCIPLINE:

- a. Encourage children to maintain good code of conduct, high standard in their general behavior and manner of speech.
- b. Severe action will be taken for any act of indiscipline.
- c. Mobile phones and other electronic gadgets once confiscated will not be returned.
- d. In case the transport is delayed for a reason, children should come and report at the school reception in Block D.

5. ATTENDANCE:

- a. Students should attend school regularly.
- b. In case of emergency, a leave letter duly signed by the parent should be sent to school.
- c. If in case the child is on leave for a day, diary note must be written on page no.88-89 and sent on the day the child is reporting back.
- d. 75% attendance is compulsory without which the student will not be allowed to appear for the final exams.
- e. Students should report back in school on the day of the reopening of school after the summer and winter vacations. Do not encourage long absence after the vacations.

6. PARENT TEACHER MEETINGS:

- a. Parents should compulsorily attend all the PTMs.
- b. The schedule of the PTMs is given in the student's calendar.
- c. Other than PTM's parents can come to the school with prior appointment between 10.35 am to 10.55 am. Please call at the reception (26841885) for prior appointment.
- d. Parents are expected to give their current contact number for sending SMS from the school. Any change should be informed to the respective class teacher.
- e. All answer sheets will be retained by the school and shall be shown to the parents during the PTM.
- f. Meeting the Principal/ Vice Principals/ teachers should be done only with prior appointment.

7. GUIDELINES FOR USING THE SCHOOL BUS:

The parents should instruct the following rules to the students:

- a. Always follow the instructions given by the bus driver.
- b. Not to hurry while getting on or off the bus and should step away when the bus approaches.
- c. Not to put the hand or head out of the window and should not stand while travelling in the bus.
- d. Should not bend to retrieve anything that is fallen under the bus. Seek the help of adults.
- e. Should not play around or near the school bus/vehicles.

8. REGISTRATION FOR CBSE BOARD EXAMINATION TO BE HELD IN MARCH 2019:

- a. Registration for the class XII Board exam to be held in March 2019 is done in class XI.
- b. The name and other details for registration shall be the same as in class X certificate.
- c. The tentative date of registration shall be informed as soon as it is declared by the board.

9. CHANGE IN SUBJECT:

- a. Change of subject(s) in class XI may be allowed by the Head of the School till 30th April 2017.
- b. After registration the students will not be allowed to change the subjects opted by them.
- c. No candidate shall be permitted to change his/her subject of study after passing class XI. Please refer to CBSE website for further details.

10. ASSIGNMENTS/PROJECTS:

- a. As the difficulty level of the curriculum increases, the students are expected to put in diligent hard work on a regular basis.
- b. Students should complete all the assignments and worksheets given in the allotted time
- c. Record books and project reports should be taken seriously and submitted well within the submission date as they carry weightage.

11. EXAMINATIONS:

- a. In class XI the students shall appear for Unit test, First term, Second term, Pre final and final examinations.
- b. The Pre final and final exam shall include the entire syllabus as prescribed by the board.
- c. The question paper shall be set according to the pattern prescribed by the board in all the examinations.
- d. Examination schedule is given in the activity and examination schedule.
- e. Practical exam is conducted twice – during II term and Final Exam in the month of November and final practical Exam in the month of February.

12. PASS CRITERIA:

- a. The qualifying marks in each subject of examination shall be 33%.
- b. However, in a subject involving practical work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in the theory and 33% marks in the practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate, in order to qualify in that subject.
- c. An aggregate of 33% will be calculated only from the marks secured in theory to qualify in the subject.
- d. For calculating the aggregate for promotion to class XII the following criteria shall be adopted:

13. COMPARTMENTAL EXAMS:

- a. A candidate failing in any one of the five subjects shall be placed in compartment in that subject.
- b. If a student fails in more than one subject then he shall be declared failed.

14. SCHOOL FEES:

- a. Kindly pay the school fees regularly.
- b. Delayed payments will result in a fine of R.O.2.000 for every month.
- c. Admit cards for examination will not be issued until all the dues are paid. Defaulters will not be allowed to appear in examination.
