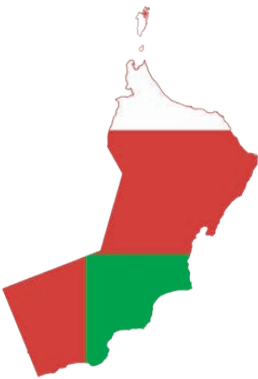

ACADEMIC TERM

The academic year commences in the first week of April and ends in March. There are two vacations, a short break at the end of December and a longer one in summer.



SCHOOL FEES

1. The annual fees for all the students will be collected in nine installments from April to December.

2. **Last date for payment of the fees every month is the 15th of the month.** If the 15th is a holiday then the next working day will be the last day for fee payment.

3. Late fee will be charged @ **RO 1/- per month** for every month of unpaid fee.

4. School rules will apply for non payment of fee beyond two months.

5. Parents can pay the school fees through any one of the following payment modes:

i) **School Mobile App:** Fee can now be paid through school mobile app using debit or credit card issued by any bank in Oman.

ii) **Parent login:** Fee can also be paid through bank payment gateway using debit or credit card issued by any bank in Oman, through the online payment link provided in the school ERP parent login (iss.josacloud.com) and on the school website.

iii) **Cash at school fee counter:** Parents can pay the fees at the school fee counter in cash on all working days (Sunday to Thursday) between 8:00 am and 1:30 pm.

iv) **Cash at Bank Muscat:** Fees can also be paid into school account no. **0343-01175965-0031** at any BANK MUSCAT branch.

* Please remember to write GR No. in the narration / remark column of cash deposit slip, without which the fee shall not be updated.

* Please remind bank staff to add GR No. in narration while entering the transaction in the computer.

v) **Net banking / mobile banking:** Fee can also be deposited using net banking /mobile banking in **Bank Muscat A/c no. 0343-01175965-0031.**

Please note the following instructions while making the fee payment at Bank / through Net banking / mobile banking:

- Pay the exact amount of fees as per the fee chart issued by the school.
- Remember to add a late fee, if applicable, while making the fee payment.
- Please write your child's G.R. No. in narration / remark while making fee payment at Bank / through Net banking / mobile banking, without which the fee shall remain in suspense account.
- On payment of fees, parents should mail the bank payment slip / acknowledgement (mobile screen shot) to accounts@indianschoolsohar.com and with Cc to office@indianschoolsohar.com, mentioning the student's G. R. No., Name, and Class & Sec. in the 'Subject' for fee reconciliation and updation in the school ERP.
- Parents can log into iss.josacloud.com with their ward's G. R. No. and check the status of paid fees after 5 working days from sending the mail. Online fee receipt for the payment done can be downloaded from here.
- **Please note that school fees payment through CDM is strictly not accepted.**



ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

An application form for the admission has to be duly filled by the parents, who will be responsible to the Head of School for the pupil's conduct, punctuality, regular attendance, progress in school and payment of fees. Please note that admission procedure will be done online. For details, visit school website

Printout of the application form (3 pages) should be submitted to the school office on any working day between 8.00 am to 11.00 am along with the following: -

1. TC original (For pupils from schools other than CBSE school, Transfer Certificated should be countersigned from the authority controlling the school).
2. Photocopy of all the documents uploaded (Bring original documents for verification).
3. Two recent passport size coloured photographs of the child.
4. Registration fee RO 6.000 and Admission fee RO 25.000 (Non-refundable). Caution money deposit (refundable) RO 100.000 to confirm the admission of their ward.
5. Resident card copy of the student (Balvatika – XII)
6. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
7. Please read the guidelines and fill the form carefully. All the entries must be correct.
8. A pupil must be three years as on 30/03/2026 for Balvatika.
9. After verification of the documents, registration notification mail will be sent.
10. The pupil must be present on the allotted test date. If due to any emergency, the pupil is not able to attend the diagnostic test then, it should be informed to the school authorities.
11. The information should be sent to our e-mail ID- "**admission@indianschoolsohar.com**" or a written application must be submitted with pupil's name, admission registration number, class in which admission is sought, date of examination and the reason, at the school office. **Telephone calls will not be entertained.**
12. In case of no information, admission form will be rejected and parents will have to again register a new online admission form.

13. A pupil can be asked to appear for a written test of all the main subjects at the time of admission. The decision of the school authorities regarding the admission will be final.
14. The pupil must bring the following materials on the allotted date of the admission test:
 - a. Admit card – compulsory for all.
 - b. For Balvatika, LKG, UKG, class I to IV – HB pencils, eraser and color pencils.
 - c. For class V onwards – Blue pen, pencil and eraser.
15. The result of the admission test will be displayed on the school notice board at the reception after three working days.
16. For diagnostic test syllabus and other details, please check the school website www.indianschoolsohar.com/admission.
- 18. Admission is subjected to the availability of the seat.**
- 19. Parents seeking admission to Class X, XI & XII, and parents of non-Indian students must contact the school and fill the admission form OFFLINE.**

Withdrawal

1. Parents should inform the school in writing at least one month in advance, of their intention to withdraw the pupil from school, or a month's fees will be charged in lieu of notice.
2. A transfer certificate, or any other certificate, will be issued only if all school dues have been paid.
3. A transfer certificate will be issued after one week from the date of application.
4. Transfer Certificate application can be obtained from the school office on payment of RO 1.000 or can be downloaded from the school website.

Admission to Class XI

Admission to class XI will be governed by the following rules:

- a. Science or Commerce Stream or Elective subjects will be allotted based on student's performance in Class X.
- b. Seats will be allotted purely based on merit.
- c. Other aspects like discipline, behaviour/study habits, etc. will also be considered.
- d. The decision of the school authorities will be final.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The school expects all the students to maintain a high standard of discipline.

- Being an English medium school, students are expected to communicate in English during the school hours.
- They should always be well mannered, courteous and considerate to the needs of others.
- They should be dedicated to their academics and actively participate in the co-curricular activities of the school.
- Violation of any of the norms of conduct is subject to an appropriate form of consequence decided by the school.
- Serious offences such as immoral behaviour, indulging in physical fights/brawls inside and outside the school campus, and damaging or defecting school property and forgery can lead to suspension or dismissal.

VIOLATION OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

- The school adopts a positive/constructive approach to the management of discipline. The students should willingly accept the norms of conduct of the school and commit to behave or act in an appropriate and desirable manner, leading to their academic excellence and overall development.
- However, misconduct will be dealt seriously and the school would be obliged to take punitive action for the purpose of deterrence and in the larger interest of the school/community.
- Irregular attendance, in-subordination to teachers, habitual inattention to schoolwork, obscenity in word or act, and any damage to school property are sufficient reasons for dismissal of a pupil.
- Discipline committee has the authority to take the final decision on any discipline matter.
- The management reserves the rights to suspend/dismiss/expel students who make no progress in their studies or whose conduct is detrimental to the orderly life of the school.

DISCIPLINE

- Students are expected to be regular in attendance and academics, obedient and respectful in their behaviour and should avoid malpractices in tests and examinations.
- Students must be on time for the morning class assembly.
- Late attendance will be entered in the diary.
- Students are not permitted to leave the classroom without apt and genuine reason and without out pass.

ATTITUDE & BEHAVIOUR

- Students are expected to maintain high standard in their general behaviour and manner of speech. Bad and improper language will not be accepted.
- English being the medium of instruction in the school, students are advised to maintain a good level of English. It is compulsory for the students to always speak in English except in classes and activities of other languages.
- They should be well-behaved, respectful to their elders, honest, truthful and are answerable to the school authorities for their conduct in and outside the school.
- Students should have deep respect and dedication to their work. Attentiveness in class and regularity in classwork, homework and assignments are of prime importance.
- Students should carry their Student Diary to school every day.

LIBRARY RULES

- Strict silence must be maintained in the library.
- Library period is strictly meant for reading books.
- No one can take a book from the library without having it duly entered.
- A student may borrow maximum of one book at a time.
- A book is issued for a period of 7 days starting from the date of issue.
- The book must be returned on the due date. If the due date happens to be a holiday the book must be returned on the next working day.

- Book can be re-issued again, if no one else requires it.
- Reference books, reserved books, new arrivals, and periodicals will not be issued and shall not be taken out of the library.
- Personal books, bags and belongings are not supposed to be brought into the library.
- In case a reader loses a book he/she should replace the book. In case the book cannot be replaced; the current price of the book will be paid by the borrower.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Kindly go through the school website.
- Personal neatness and cleanliness are always appreciated.
- Nails should be clipped short and clean. Growing long nails and using nail polish are not permitted in the school.
- Short and neat haircut for boys. Fancy cuts or styles are not permitted.
- Beard or stubble is not permitted. Girls must tie up / plait long hair.
- Both boys and girls must refrain from using hair colours.
- Girls are permitted to wear small earrings .
- Caps to be worn only in the Sun if required.
- Winter Uniform: The winter uniform is a navy blue sweater / cardigan worn over the school uniform. Jackets, hoodies etc. are not permitted. Also students can wear navy blue woolen cap. Ear muffs are not permitted.
- Legging is compulsory for girls.

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

- Children are not allowed to elaborately celebrate their birthdays in the school.
- Wear sober , simple Indian dress.
- Only small toffees are allowed. Please do not bring big chocolates.
- Do not go to other classes for toffee distribution
- Do not go to staff rooms/other classes during library, or other co-curricular periods.

FIRST-AID ROOM

- School provides first aid facility to the students and staff members.
- Students can visit first aid room located in block A ground floor in any emergency.
- Students should take permission from the teacher to visit the first aid room. They should go with proper out pass.
- Do not take a classmate for help and support, if not required.
- Any student feeling unwell will be sent to the medical room.
- If a child is found to be very sick, he/she will be sent home .
- For any emergency, children will be sent to the hospital and parents will be informed.
- Please do not send a child to the school if the child is sick.

LEAVE RULES

- Students must be regular to school.
- Leave of absence is granted only for valid reasons and with the prior written application /e-mail of the parent.
- If a student is absent from school even for a day, it is imperative that the parent sends a leave note addressed to the class teacher on the very next day, which will be filed for future reference. It is advised, the parent must inform the class teacher through mail on the same day. Mail should be sent from the parent's registered e mail id.
- In case of long leave, e-mail/leave application addressed to the class teacher should be handed over in advance to the class teacher, who in turn will submit it to the supervisor.
- If any student doesn't fulfil the criteria of 75% attendance due to long absence, the student may be detained in the same class.
- During periodical examination and tests and other days, students must remain present in the school for the entire day. They are not allowed to go home. If unwell, students can send medical leave with certificate.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school premises without the permission of the Principal, Vice-Principal or administrator in case of emergency. The student may be allowed to leave the school only with the parent or authorized person the parent has deputed with identity
- A student suffering with any contagious disease should not be sent to school.

VALUABLES & GADGETS

- The school does not accept responsibility for the loss of books, money, clothes, jewellery, mobile phones, etc. Each child is responsible for his/her own things.
- Parents are advised not to allow their children to bring any valuables to school.
- Objectionable literature, Mobiles / Smart Phones/ Smart Watches, Internet material and films – audio and videos, DVDs, Pen Drives, electronic gadgets, harmful and illegal material and substances etc. are strictly prohibited in school.
- Mobiles and other electronic gadgets are strictly not allowed.
- If confiscated, gadgets will be returned only at the end of the session.
- Violation of the same will lead to immediate dismissal.

LOST AND FOUND

- Parents are requested to label (name, class & section) all the items like sweaters, lunch box and any other personal possessions.
- Do not bring items that are not needed in the school, especially valuable ones.
- If any item is missing, kindly contact the school reception at the earliest.
- Any item that is not being claimed will be donated after a month.

LUNCH BREAK

- Use napkin/ mat on the desk for eating tiffin.
- Bring fork/ spoon for eating.
- Bring healthy and nutritious food. Junk food is not allowed.
- Remember to wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before and after eating food.

BUNKING CLASS

Bunking classes or being found outside the school during school hours will be severely dealt with.

FORGING SIGNATURES

Forging parent's signature and changing marks or entries in diary/report cards or elsewhere may warrant a disciplinary action.

EXAMINATION RULES

Guidelines for students:

- Students are required to bring their own pen, pencil, and stationery items. Only blue black or royal blue ink/ball point pen is to be used. Stationery must be brought in a transparent pouch only.
- No student shall leave his/her seat or the examination hall until the end of the examination without the permission of the invigilator.
- No student shall speak without the permission of the invigilator. If it is necessary for the candidate to communicate, he/she shall stand up in his/her place and the invigilator will see to his/her requirement.
- Answers shall be written on both sides of the answer book. No student shall tear out any leaf from the answer book.
- On the expiry of time the answer book must be handed over to the invigilator irrespective whether the student has answered the paper in full or in part or not at all.
- Students can be physically searched by the invigilators before or during the examination at any time.
- The student shall not ask for supplementary answer sheet till the main answer book/the earlier supplementary answer book is filled.

UNFAIR MEANS

If during examination, a student is found indulging in any of the following, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair means-

- Passing signals to others during the examination.
- Taking away the answer sheets out of the examination room.
- Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by school from time to time.
- Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination.
- Uploading/sharing any examination related material, correct or wrong, on social media.
- Providing wrong information on the answer sheet.

ACTION & PENALTY

- Answer sheet will be taken by the invigilator along with the confiscated /used material.
- Parents will be intimated to come and meet the disciplinary committee.
- Students involved in the use of unfair means will stay back after the examination and will go home along with the parent only.
- A student adopting unfair means in an examination will be disqualified in that subject. He/she will be awarded zero in that examination.
- In serious cases, the student may permanently be debarred from the school from taking any school-based examination.

4. Students will not be excused from the school before the end of the school day, unless there is an emergency. Students will only be sent with the parents. Gate pass will be issued from the reception and must be presented to the guard.
5. Students are not to arrive prior to 7.30 am and should leave by 12.30/ 2.30 pm as no supervision is provided before 7.30 am and after 12.30/2.30 pm.
 - Prompt pickup is important to ensure your child's safety.
 - In case the transport is delayed for any reason, the child should immediately come and report to the school reception (Block D) and inform, so that the parent can be contacted.
6. Visiting hours to be observed as per the schedule. Kindly call at 26841885 a day prior to fix an appointment.
7. KG to class II parents must accompany their children all the time during drop and pick-up. Please do not leave the children unescorted especially after picking them up from the class.
8. Please avoid sending tiffin, books, pen and other material during school hours. Due to logistic constraints, it becomes very difficult to send materials to different classes.
9. Advise children to set their bags according to the time table.
10. Parents are requested to restrict the use of mobile phone in school premises, especially during drop and pick up.

- Regularly checking the student diary, water bottles, tiffin boxes and the bags of their ward.
- Encouraging their children to take part in the activities of the school.
- Seeing all test/examination papers, report cards, etc. and entries made in the student diary, whether satisfactory or not.
- Informing the Principal about the child's absence for any reason within a week.
- Intimating any change of address or telephone number to the school.
- Keeping their children at home when infected with some infectious/contagious disease, till the danger of the infection has passed.
- Visiting the Principal or the Vice-Principal only on a working day, within the stipulated hours.
