GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS
CLASSES: VI-XII

Dear Parents & Students,

Kindly note:

- Students must bring the Admit Card and ID Card.
- All writing materials, including pens, pencils, erasers, etc., should be brought in a transparent pouch.
- Students are allowed to bring a transparent water bottle during the examination.
- Electronic devices such as mobile phones, smartwatches, and other restricted gadgets are not permitted inside the examination hall.
- Use only blue ink/ballpoint pens for writing. The use of whitener is not permitted.
- Any attempt to cheat, communicate with others, or engage in unfair practices may result in strict action, including disqualification.
- Students should maintain silence, stay focused, and follow all rules for a smooth and orderly examination process.
- No student shall leave his/her seat or the examination hall until the end of the examination without the permission of the invigilator.
- No student shall speak without the permission of the invigilator. If it is necessary for the student to communicate, he/she shall stand up in his place, and the invigilator will see to his/her requirement.
- The answers shall be written on both sides of the answer book. No student shall tear out any leaf from the answer book.
- Frisking will be done by the invigilators before or during the examinations at any time.
- The student shall not ask for a supplementary answer sheet till the main answer book/the earlier supplementary answer book is filled.

(IX & X Science & Social Science Q.P.)

- The **Science question paper** will consist of **three sections**, while the **Social Science question paper** will consist of **four sections**.
- Students will divide the answer book into 3 sections for Science and 4 sections for Social Science for writing answers.
- Science : Section A - Biology, B- Physics, C- Chemistry
- Social Science : Section A - History, B- Geography, C- Political Sci. D- Economics
- Answers to the questions must be written only in the space allotted for the respective section.



- Answers belonging to one section must not be written or mixed with any other section.
- If answers are written in the wrong section or mixed with another section, they will not be evaluated and no marks will be awarded.

Unfair means:

- Passing signals to others during the examinations.
- Taking away the answer sheets out of the examination room.
- Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by school from time to time.
- Using or attempting to use any other undesirable methods or means in connection with the examinations.

Action and Penalty:

- Parents will be intimated to come and meet the disciplinary committee.
- Student will be awarded zero in the examination.

Class (IX) Passing Criteria (2026-27)

- A minimum of 33% marks must be secured separately in both theory and internal assessments to pass.
- Theory (80 marks exam): Students must score at least 27 marks out of 80 in the annual examination.
- Internal Assessment (20 marks): Students must score at least 7marks out of 20 in internal evaluations.

Admission to class XI (2027-28)

- Kindly note that streams Science/Commerce or Elective subjects will be allotted purely on the basis of merit and availability of seats.
- For stream allotment, the marks of Periodic Tests & Pre-Board Examination will be taken into consideration.
- Other aspects like discipline, behaviour, etc. will also be considered.
