## ☀️ Healthy Routines & Good Manners

### ☀️ Start the Day Right

Guide your little ones to greet elders with love, warmth, and respect every single day.

### 🧼 Habits & Hygiene

Encourage brushing teeth twice daily, washing hands thoroughly, keeping fingernails neat and trimmed, and putting away toys neatly.

### 🧠 Magic Words

Inculcate good manners into daily conversation. Practice using the magic words consistently: *Please, Thank You, Sorry, and Excuse Me.*

### 👕 Growing Independent

Practice life skills like buttoning/unbuttoning shirts, zipping up trousers smoothly, organizing their toy shelf, and learning to wear shoes/socks.

### ⚽ Stay Active & Screen Free

Reduce screen/mobile usage drastically. Dedicate a weekly "No Screen Day". Instead, explore cycling, swimming, and fun interactive ball games outdoors.

### 📖 Family & Story Time

Spend premium quality time reading high-quality moral storybooks aloud. Share childhood memories or flipped through family photo albums together!





## Academic Focus & Language Foundation

**Language Tip:** Most children understand standard instructions given in English, but it is deeply important that your child learns to express themselves confidently. Please converse regularly in English at home!

### Nursery Focus

- Practice basic writing strokes to develop hand-muscle strength.

⚠ **Note:** Please use a rough layout sheet; do not practice in regular school notebooks.

### LKG Focus

- Regularly practice alphabet phonic sounds and practice neatly writing letters.

⚠ **Note:** Please practice inside a separate four-line notebook (not in school notebooks).

### UKG Focus

- Practice writing words in a four-line notebook.
- Practice writing math numbers from 1 to 40 clearly inside a square-line notebook.

⚠ **Note:** Please do not complete this practice work inside official school notebooks.



## Kindergarten Summer Creative Activities



### Nursery Assignment: Beautiful Palm Printing


- **Instructions:** Dip your child's palm safely in colorful, non-toxic washable paint and make vibrant palm prints directly on clean A4- size paper.
- **Creative Transformation:** Using the dried palm prints, encourage children to build creative shapes of their choice—such as animals, birds, trees, flowers, fish, butterflies, cartoon characters, or sceneries.
- **Details:** Children may use coloured sketch pens, wax crayons, or scrap coloured paper to add beautiful finer details to their art work.
- Encourage them to work independently with minimum parental interference. Keep the final presentation colourful, tidy, and expressive!


## LKG Assignment: My First Story Scroll


- **Concept:** Help your creative child construct a beautiful, flowing sequential "Story Scroll" using drawing, active colouring, and interesting cut-out pictures.
- **Process:** Pick any classic, easy-to-understand moral story (e.g., *The Thirsty Crow*, *The Lion and the Mouse*, or any short familiar tale).
- Draw or paste illustrations in strict chronological sequence along a long horizontal continuous sheet of paper (scroll format). Let your child handle colouring tasks meticulously.
- **Narration Challenge:** Prompt your child to practice narrating the story flow in basic English sentences.
- *Ensure maximum child ownership and interaction with parent guidance only.* Parents are invited to share a short video clip of the narration on Facebook with the tag: **#ISSoharCreativeCorner**

## UKG Assignment: Creative Leaf Art Fusion

- **Instructions:** Step out into nature and collect distinct dry or fresh fallen leaves of completely different shapes, textures, and sizes.
- **Composition:** Use the leaves to create a picture of your choice, such as: animals, birds, trees, flowers, scenery, cartoon characters, etc.
- Paste the leaves neatly on an A4-size paper.


