**Holiday Homework:**

**English**

**Vocabulary Tree** 🌳

**Objective:**

Learn and use new English words creatively.

**Materials Needed:**

- Chart paper
- Pencil and eraser
- Colored pens, crayons, or sketch pens
- Ruler (optional)

**Instructions:**

1. Draw a large tree on the chart paper. Make a strong trunk and many branches.
2. Create at least **30 leaves** on the tree.
3. Write **one new vocabulary word** on each leaf.
4. Under each leaf (or beside it), write:

- **Meaning** of the word
  - **One sentence** using the word correctly
5. Use neat handwriting and correct spelling.
  6. Decorate your tree with colours, fruits, flowers, birds, or other creative designs.
  7. Make sure all 30 words are different.
  8. Your work should be clean, colorful, and easy to read.

**Example:**

**Leaf Word:** Brave

**Meaning:** Showing courage; not afraid.

**Sentence:** The brave firefighter rescued the kitten from the tree

- **The Activity:** Students create a personalized Hindi dictionary on A4-size sheets or a scrapbook. They can find 25-30 new words in their textbook, newspaper, or everyday life.
- **Creative Twist:** They must write the Hindi word, draw a colorful picture next to it, and include its English meaning, a synonym (पर्यायवाची), and an antonym (विलोम).

Section C & D: Symmetrical Rangoli on canvas

Section E & F: Tessellation on canvas

Section G & H: Indian Mathematicians – Any two Indian Mathematicians

**Eco-Friendly Waste Sorter**

Learn about recycling and how to care for our environment.

- **Activity:** Create a mini waste segregation station at home using two small cartons or baskets. Label one for "Dry Waste" (e.g., plastics, paper) and the other for "Wet Waste" (e.g., fruit peels, leftover food).
- **Creative Output:** Make an eye-catching awareness poster on an A4 sheet explaining why we should separate our waste, and list 3 easy ways to reduce garbage in the house.
