HEAT WAVE SAFETY

Greetings!

The current heat wave situation in Oman has led to intense daytime temperatures, and as responsible educators, we need to prioritize the well-being of our students. To ensure their safety, we have established a set of guidelines:

- Outdoor activities during school hours will be suspended to protect students from direct sunlight.
- 2. Students are encouraged to apply sunscreen to protect themselves from harmful UV rays.
- 3. Access to the field during recess will be restricted to minimize heat exposure.
- 4. Students should stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water.
- 5. Parents are requested to pick up their children on time to minimize sun exposure.
- 6. Students should remain indoors or in shaded areas until they are picked up.
- Students should carry their own water bottles and caps when outside to stay hydrated and protect themselves from the sun.
- 8. Students coming to school on foot or bicycle should keep their heads covered and may use an umbrella.
- Parents are advised to include seasonal fresh fruits and vegetables in their children's lunch boxes to keep them hydrated and boost their immunity.
- 10. Students should be educated about the symptoms of heat-related illness and they must report immediately to teachers.
