Dear Parents,

Sub: CBSE registration of class IX students for session 2024-25.

Kindly note the following important points for registration of your ward with CBSE.

1. We request you to fill up the Google form sent to your ward's e-mail ID and submit it (Click "Submit" button) on or before 15th May 2024.
2. The details such as name, date of birth etc., should be exactly same as given in the passport.
3. Leave a space between parts of full name. Please fill up the details in capital letters only. e.g. ABHAY PRATAP SINGH. Please ensure that all particulars with regard to your child that are filled in this form are correct. Note that further changes in any item filled in the form will not be possible. School will not accept requests from parents in this regard.
4. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC should submit caste certificate obtained from Village Officer/Taluk Officer in India on or before 08th August 2024 CBSE Cell, Block C, Ground floor otherwise remark "General" will be entered in the column for caste.
5. Please submit a copy of the latest passport of the student (First page and the last page that shows the details of parents and the student) to the class teacher on or before 15th May 2024.
6. CBSE extends several concessions/exemptions for Children with special needs (CWSN). For details refer to the CBSE website. Parents of children with special needs, should fill up, CWSN Annexure C and CWSN Annexure D and submit to CBSE Cell, C Block, Ground floor on or before 08th August 2024.
7. Kindly save a copy of the Google form for future reference.
8. Photos of the students for registration will be taken in school during school hours on 26th and 27th May 2024. Students are requested to come in grey school uniform on these days.
9. Fee for the registration and photo will be intimated later.
10. Please note that the school fee till May 2024 should be cleared before proceeding for registration.
11. Once again parents are requested to check the details carefully, before submitting the form.
12. Two levels of mathematics examinations in the Board Examination for class X.

As per the CBSE guidelines, two levels of examinations will be held in the subject of Mathematics in the Board examination for Class X. Although the syllabus, classroom teaching and internal assessment for both the exams will remain the same, the difficulty level for these exams will be different.

Mathematics-Basic will be the easier level of the examination. Mathematics Standard will be meant for students who wish to pursue Mathematics in their Senior Secondary level, whereas Mathematics Basic will be for the students who are not keen on pursuing Mathematics at the Senior Secondary level.

We request you to guide your ward to choose the level of examination, keeping in mind her/his aptitude for Mathematics and the stream, she / he wishes to select in Class XI.
